Your new bus service between Lydney and Chepstow



Newport Bus have been busy working with Gloucestershire County Council to secure a new service for your local area.

Your new route 72 starts on 21 November 2022 and will replace the Lydney to Chepstow section former service 24.

We look forward to welcoming you onboard soon. In the meantime, we've put together the answers to some frequently asked questions...

Who are Newport Bus?

Let us introduce ourselves...

We've been the main provider of buses in Newport for over 100 years. We're still locally owned and managed too.

We offer a comprehensive network of services across the city as well as services to and from Bristol, Cardiff, Monmouth and of course Chepstow. We also provide the local services around the neighbourhoods of Chepstow town.

There's a small team of drivers dedicated to your local routes so you'll soon see some familiar, friendly faces.

Some of the buses used on your new service will be brand new, zero emission electric vehicles too.



What is the route of the new service?

Our buses will follow a similar route to that of the old service 24 - Chepstow bus station, Beachley Road, Tutshill, Stroath, Woolaston, Alvington, Aylburton and Church Road to Lydney bus station.

What is the timetable?

The timetable on Monday to Friday is based on that of the former route 24 with a few adjustments. Our Saturday timetable is a little different.

On Monday to Friday, buses leave Lydney bus station for Chepstow at 0728, 0938, 1138, 1338, 1648, 1848

On Saturdays buses are at 0938, 1138, 1338, 1538, 1738.

On Monday to Friday, buses leave Chepstow bus station for Lydney at 0652, 0902, 1102, 1302, 1612, 1812

On Saturdays buses are at 0902, 1102, 1302, 1502, 1702.

We've displayed the full timetable at most bus stops and we've dropped off some printed copies at places along the route.

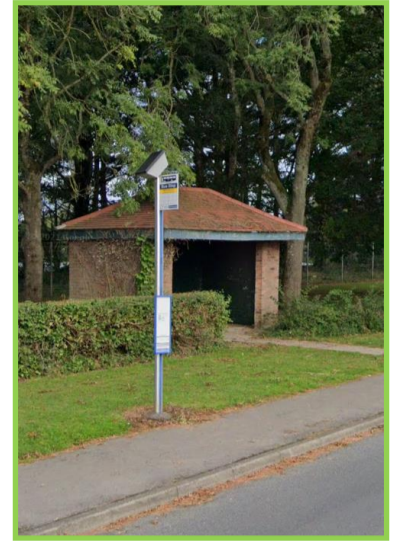
Our drivers will have some too or, give us a call and we'll post one out to you. You can view timetables and track your bus on our website or by downloading the Newport Bus app.

Does the bus just stop at the points in the timetable, or can I get on at other bus stops?

We only show the main stops in the timetable but you can get on and off at any stop along the route.

Can I hail the bus at other places that are not bus stops?

It's always easier and safer to wait at bus stops with a sign or shelter, but we know there are a few long established stops along the route that are not marked. Where there isn't a sign, we'll always do our best to stop where it is convenient, but we'd be grateful if you would respect the driver's decision - we want you and our other customers to be safe. Our drivers are new to the area so please let them know where you need the bus to stop. In the Chepstow and Lydney town centre area we can only stop at the bus station or Tesco.



What are the fares?

You can pay by contactless on all our buses. If you prefer to use cash, you'll need the exact fare please - just drop your coins in the slot next to the ticket machine.

We've introduced the new Forest of Dean ticket allowing unlimited travel on routes 72 & C4:

Travelling further? We offer a range of daily and weekly tickets. You can buy from your driver or on our app. Full details are on our website.

Can I use my bus pass?

You can use your bus pass with us in the same way you have previously use it for travelling locally.

English Concessionary Bus Pass

You can use your pass with us anytime after 09:30 on Monday to Friday and anytime on Saturdays. You can travel between any stop in England. You can also travel to/from Chepstow. Unfortunately, your pass is not valid for travel solely in Wales.



Welsh Concessionary Bus Pass

You can use your pass with us anytime on any day. You can travel between any stop in Wales to a stop in England and make the same journey in return. Unfortunately, your pass is not valid for travel solely in England.



Will you be doing more to promote the service?

Absolutely. We'll be updating bus stops along the route, providing posters for notice boards as well as printing new timetable leaflets.
