

Elective Home Education in Gloucestershire

Update



What should schools do if parents are suggesting they wish to Electively Home Educate?

- Offer a Transition to EHE discussion with the parents and invite a representative from the LA
- If parents still wish to Home Educate, they need to send in a **letter** to the school stating their wishes
- The school then completes the **Deregistration Form via Jadu** attaching the following documents:
 - Transition to EHE discussion, if held,*
 - Parent notification*
 - Safeguarding file, if one is held*
- If a parent is considering or has already decided to home educate a child who has a Child Protection Plan or a Child in Need (CIN) Plan, the school should notify the child's social worker. If you have any concerns about the safeguarding or risky behaviours of a child, who is going to be Home Educated, then please submit a MARF directly to the MASH

Deregistration process

The following form should be completed by schools only:

Please note: in order to complete this form, you will need:

- a copy of the written notification from parents of their intentions to withdraw and home educate their child;
- any safeguarding files before being able to submit this form;
- any EHE transition discussion notes.

The form should be completed within 3 days of receiving confirmation from parents.

Common Transfer File CTF

- When deregistering for EHE, schools are no longer required to upload the CTF file to the LA.
- If a child goes to school in the future following a period of home education, school can still generate the CTF and share with the new school.
