

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ONE WAY) (NORTHGATE STREET) (WESTGATE WARD) (GLOUCESTER CITY)
ORDER 2025

Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Parts II and IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule, hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on **2025** and may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council (One Way) (Northgate Street) (Westgate Ward) (Gloucester City) Order 2025".

(ii) The Order affects a road in the Westgate Ward within the City of Gloucester in the County of Gloucestershire.

2. In this Order –

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order.

3. No person shall cause or permit any Vehicle except with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform to proceed along that length of road described in Column 1 ("the Road") to the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") other than in the direction specified in Column 2 to the Schedule

4. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following is hereby revoked as specified in the sub-Article that follows:
