

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(30, 40 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS)
(VARIOUS ROADS) (FIDDINGTON AND WALTON CARDIFF)
(TEWKESBURY BOROUGH)
ORDER 2024**

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on the 21st November 2024 and may be cited as the "GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (30, 40 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIOUS ROADS) (FIDDINGTON AND WALTON CARDIFF) (TEWKESBURY BOROUGH) ORDER 2024".

(ii) This Order affects roads within the Parish of Ashchurch within the Borough of Tewkesbury in the County of Gloucestershire.
2. In this Order –

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of roads described in the First Schedule at a speed exceeding 30 MPH.
4. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of roads described in the Second Schedule at a speed exceeding 40 MPH.
5. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of roads described in the Third Schedule at a speed exceeding 50 MPH.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following Orders are to be revoked:
 - (i) GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, FIDDINGTON AND WALTON CARDIFF, TEWKESBURY), (30,40 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2007
 - (ii) GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FIDDINGTON) (40 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2011

40293 (Known in part as Walton Cardiff Lane & in part as Walton Cardiff Road.	From its junction with the Ashchurch Road (A438) to a point 74m south-west of its junction with Walton Cardiff Road (40406)
Walton Cardiff Road (40406)	From its junction with Walton Cardiff Road (40293) for a distance of 246m in a generally eastern direction

C87 (Known in part as Natton and in part as Road from Natton to Homedowns)	From a point 42m south of its junction with Platinum Drive (72723) to a point 29m south of its junction with Natton (50268)
Natton (40290) (50268)	For its entire length
C87 (Known in part as Road from Natton to Homedowns, Homedowns, Road from Homedowns to Northwest of Rectory Farm and Walton Cardiff Road to Newtown Farm Ashchurch)	From a point 12m north of its junction with Homedowns (40290) to a point 7m south of its junction with Monks Lane (50322)
Walton Cardiff Road (40406)	From its junction with Walton Cardiff Road to Newtown Farm Ashchurch (C87) for a distance of 19m in a north-westerly direction
Claydon (50270)	For its entire length
Homedowns (40290) (50269)	For its entire length
